

A Third Bank Presidency to W. T. Kemper, Jr.

William T. Kemper, jr., was elected president of the First National Bank of Independence yesterday when Bernard Zick, jr., president since 1906, became chairman of the board. It is the young man's third bank presidency, as he already heads, at 25, years, the Citizens National Bank of Frankfort, Kas., and the Kemper; State Bank of Boonville, Mo. For three years Mr. Kemper has been working as an active executive in his father's Kemper Investment Company, a company that is to play an increasingly important part in the investment field here and already is a large holder in bank stocks.

The three sons of William T. Kemper are all bank executives, R. Crosby Kemper as president of the City Bank, James M. Kemper as president of the Commerce Trust Company and William T. Kemper, jr., as president of the three banks mentioned and as Vice-president of two banks in Oklahoma.
